


BELLA SWAN

Bella Swan (age 18 at signing): Isabella Honora Jane Campbell Swan, born 1873 at Cooramook, was the fourth of nine children of John Swan and Jane (Campbell) Swan, the younger sister of Maggie. Like her siblings, she attended Ballangeich West (Cooramook) SS and lived her younger years at her family home in Cooramook. As the children grew many of the males sought employment on station properties belonging to relatives and some bought a property which they named 'Woodburn Park', near Warragul. Bella lived later in life with another branch of the family at Sheep Hills near Warracknabeal, however further research is needed to ascertain other details of her life. She died in May 1917 at Kew Mental Asylum and is buried at Booroondara Cemetery.
