EDITORIAL

I have been asked to increase the rate of publication of the details in the Register for Warrnambool Agricultural High School, so three pages (99 entries) this month. The column headed "Date" refers to the recorded enrolment date - different people entered this in different ways. Sometimes, the Term and Year were noted, hence T1, 09 and similar. On other occasions, month and year were recorded, giving entries such as 4, 09 or 2, 11.

The October 1897 and 1922 Historicals, compiled as usual by Betty Beavis, provide further information, challenges, and pointers to on-going research. Interesting to see that some things never change - a dog attack on an 8 year old boy. Noted movements for Bank and Public Service staff of various kinds indicate a remarkable flexibility. Why would you drag the *Nestor* by horse a cart to Melbourne, when a sea trip by barge might have been much easier?

Marie Boyce's two vignettes provide interesting background to life in early times, and also give starting points for "digging".

A ROMANCE OF REAL LIFE

One Mr Malony, hotel keeper, Dobie's Bridge, Langi Ghirin, received a letter stating his daughter had arrived from Ireland, and was anxious to be fetched out of the depot at Melbourne. Accordingly the father and mother started by first coach, and on their arrival speedily repaired to the depot for their desired treasure; but some questions were wisely asked by the Governor and matron in charge of the female immigrants. They first wanted to know the appearance of the young woman required; and lest there should be a mistake in her identity, should they know her if they saw her, or would she know them? To each enquiry the answer was no. Then what was to be done? The kind and loving parents said she is our daughter, though we know her not, so she was permitted to leave, and with joy they brought her into the presence of a dear uncle, who only left her, a pet favourite, with her grandmother, in Ireland, about two years ago; so when she got home, and saw her uncle, all was right, after fourteen years absence from her parents.
